

FEATURED SPEAKER

Rusty Schmidt, co-author of *The Blue Thumb Guide to Raingardens*, will be the featured speaker.



Mr. Schmidt is a landscape ecologist employed by the Washington Conservation District in Minnesota. Mr. Schmidt designs and constructs alternative methods for managing stormwater runoff. He has created hundreds of designs for habitat restorations, rain gardens, bio-infiltration swales, bio-retention basins, and stormwater ponds. His rain garden projects have ranged in size from small backyard rain gardens to large multi-acre rain gardens.

Mr. Schmidt helps train homeowners and design professionals on the techniques of rain gardens nationwide. He has assisted rain garden initiatives like the "10,000 Rain Garden Initiative" in Kansas City and the MetroBlooms and BlueThumb Programs in Minnesota. He is a co-author of three books, two on plant selections for stormwater management and a homeowner guide to rain gardens.
